Assume that (a) t'iləm-lə-sxw is a verb. What part of speech are the (b) and (c) forms? Don't worry about all the unusual letters and diacritics; they are irrelevant to your answer. Pay attention to the meaning of the suffixes that are attached to each word (-lə, which means past, and -sxw, which means second person singular subject).

b) si'em-lə-sxw chief-PAST-2SG.NOI "You were a chief."	M 
c) sey'si-lə-sxw afraid-PAST-2SG.NC "You were afraid."	0M
